

**Kwansei Gakuin University Levels of Restrictions on University Activities****Status of Community Infections**

(State of emergency) At this level, a state of emergency has been declared in Hyogo and Osaka prefectures, requests for business closures have been issued by local governments, and the situation has been evaluated as extremely serious

**Level 5 (Full restrictions)**

(Explosive spread of infections) At this level, almost all of the government's six indicators for levels of infection have exceeded the standards for "Stage 4," as established by the government's Subcommittee on Novel Coronavirus Disease Control. A state of emergency has been declared (not accompanied by requests for business closures), and the situation has been evaluated as requiring extreme caution

**Level 4 (Major restrictions)**

(Rapid increase in infections) At this level, almost all of the government's six indicators for levels of infection have met the standards for "Stage 3," as established by the government's Subcommittee on Novel Coronavirus Disease Control. The situation has been evaluated as requiring extreme caution

**Level 3 (Partial restrictions)**

(Increase in infections and scattered infections) At this level, almost all of the government's six indicators for the level of infections have fallen below the standards for "Stage 3," as established by the government's Subcommittee on Novel Coronavirus Disease Control. Infection trends should be monitored

**Level 2 (Some restrictions)****Level 1**

At this level, infections can be prevented and kept under control
