- [Note] 1. Enter values in blank columns. Shaded columns contain formulas.
- Create this table in A3 size. Print it in one page as far as possible for submission. If the printing extend to several pages, set the printing so that the line showing the "School/Graduate School" and the "Department/Graduate Department" appears on every page.
 - Round the values of "Ratio of Enrolled Students to Admission Capacity," "Ratio of Enrollment to Admission Quota (Average of 5 Years)" and "Ratio of Transfer Students to Transfer Student Quota" to the second decimal place.
 - When a school adopts a day/evening course system, record information separately for the courses mainly conducted in the daytime and those in the evening.
 - If the course term of a school or a department is 4 years, enter values for 5 years starting from 2008 in the "Enrollment" and the "Admission Quota" columns. When the course term is 6 years, enter values for 6 years starting from 2007. For master's, doctoral and professional degree courses, enter values for 5 years starting from 2008.
 - Create tables of correspondence courses, special courses and separate courses in conformity with the table of the undergraduate school.

For a school or department that was established less than 5 years ago, modify the formula so that the number of years match the actual years that have passed since the establishment of the school or department.

- [Note by KG] 1. The School of Policy Studies conducts student recruitment of all its departments together. Students are divided into departments that they choose in their 2nd year. Accordingly, this table shows the admission quotas of each department of this school for students in the 2nd year.
- In the "Enrolled Students" column of the School of Policy Studies, the figure in the left portion shows the number of 1st year students before they join a department, and the figure in the right portion shows the number of 2nd and upper year students after they are allocated to departments.
 - In the "2012 Admission Capacity" column of the School of Policy Studies, the figure in the left portion shows the capacity for 1st year students and those in the right portion shows the capacity for 2nd and upper year students plus transfer students.
 - In the "Ratio of Enrolled Students to Admission Capacity" column of the School of Policy Studies, the figure in the left portion shows the ratio of 1st year students and the figure in the right portion shows the ratio of students in 2nd and upper years.
 - Become 1 Department (Department of Education) from 2013, The School of Education's 2 department. Department of Early Childhood and Elementary Education, Student Recruitment (first-year student) has been suspended since 2013. Department of Applied Education, Student Recruitment has been suspended since 2013.
 - Department of Mathematical Sciences, including a master's degree Mathematical Sciences.
 - The enrollment, are not included in re-enrollment.
 - The total number of transfer student ratio of transfer student capacity is, the proportion containing the incorporation number of students of all undergraduate.
 - Enrollment in the fall semester are not included in the enrollment of the latest year.
